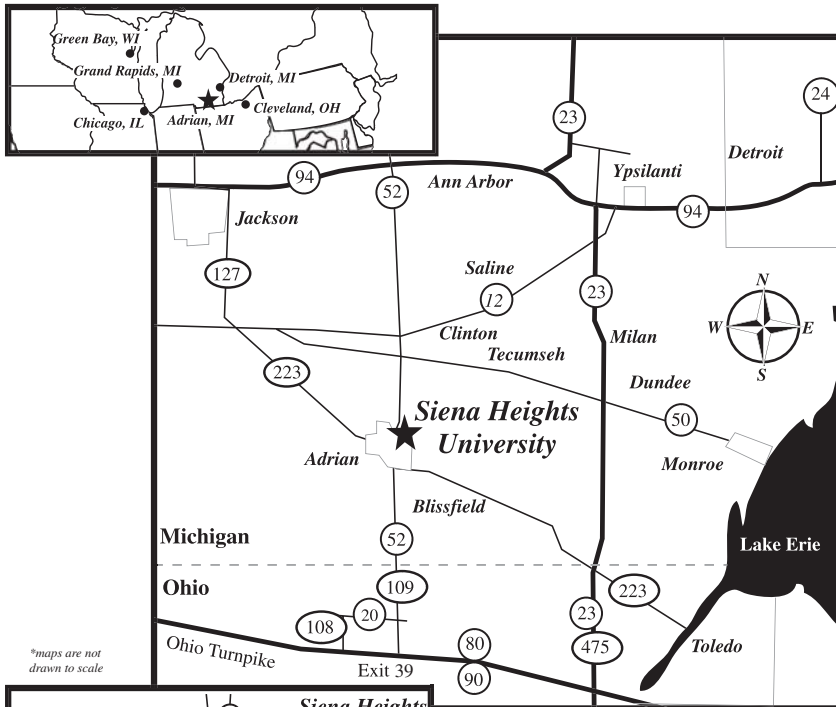
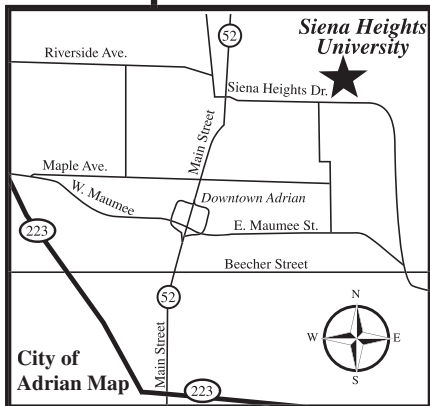


# DIRECTIONS

## To Siena Heights University

### FROM CLEVELAND, OHIO OR POINTS EAST

- West I-80/90 to exit 39 (Ohio 109)
- Turn north onto Hwy 109 (109 becomes M-52 when you cross the Michigan-Ohio Line)
- Continue north on M-52
- M-52 becomes Main Street when you enter Adrian. Follow Main Street north through downtown Adrian.
- Continue north until Siena Heights Drive, turn right and follow to Siena Heights University

### FROM CHICAGO

- West on I-94
- Exit south on US-127
- Pick up US-223 and continue to M-52 and turn north (left) on M-52
- M-52 becomes Main Street when you enter Adrian. Follow Main Street north through downtown Adrian.
- Continue north until Siena Heights Drive, turn right and follow to Siena Heights University

### FROM DETROIT

- West I-94 to West US-12, continue on US-12 to M-52
- Turn left (south) on M-52 and continue to east Siena Heights Drive
- Turn left and continue east to Siena Heights University



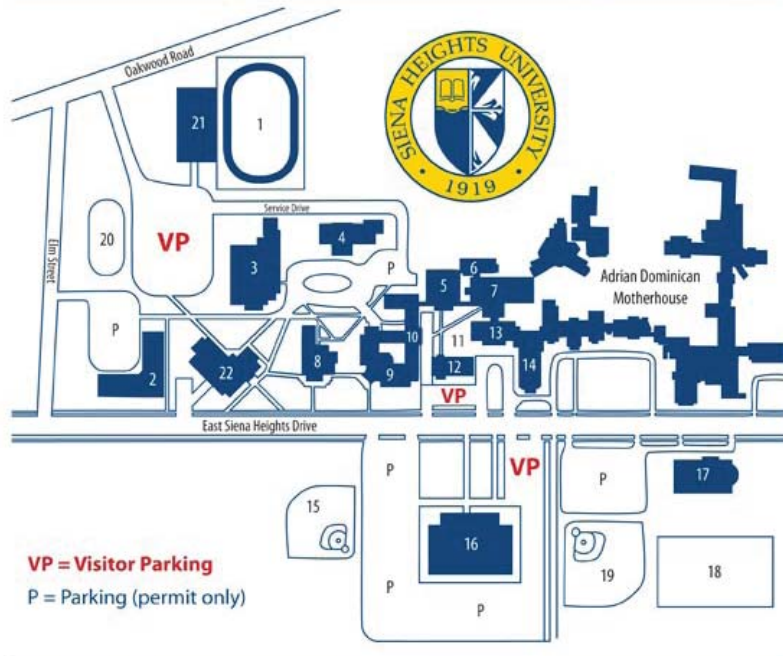

# INSIDE THE STADIUM

## O'LAUGHLIN STADIUM GATE POLICY

The following items are prohibited from entering O'Laughlin Stadium: weapons, animals, glass containers, umbrellas, flags, alcoholic beverages, video cameras and projectile toys. Siena Heights University is a tobacco free campus, including O'Laughlin Stadium and parking areas. All items brought into O'Laughlin Stadium are subject to search. Changes in national security levels may affect security procedures at O'Laughlin Stadium. Siena Heights University reserves the right to refuse access to the stadium or to remove individuals at their discretion.

## SAFETY AT O'LAUGHLIN STADIUM

Athletic officials and University Public Safety personnel have completed emergency response plans for a variety of situations at O'Laughlin Stadium. We hope these emergencies never occur, but we are prepared if they do. This information will help you know what to do to contribute to a safe environment for all.

## FIRST AID

The Department of Public Safety is on duty at O'Laughlin Stadium and surrounding parking areas during football games. They are trained in basic First Aid/CPR and many members are Medical First Response certified. Should you require medical assistance, please see a Siena Heights University Event Staff Team Member.

## WHAT YOU SHOULD DO

Based on the nature of a specific event or emergency, directions to fans and staff will be communicated via public address announcements. Emergency sheltering locations may include the Performing Arts Center, Studio Angelico and other nearby facilities. Fans are requested to listen to announcements and remain seated until instructed otherwise.

## LOST & FOUND

Found items can be given to a Department of Public Safety Officer. Anyone inquiring about a lost item may do so at the Welcome Center in Ledwidge Hall or by calling 517-263-0731.

# PARKING RULES & TIPS

- Season parking passes are pre-sold via Siena Heights University Athletic Department for parking in the Stadium Lot on football game days. Weather permitting there is public parking in the grassy area adjacent to the Stadium Lot for \$5. Other accessible free parking for football game days is located in the East Fieldhouse Lot and the grassy areas surrounding the softball field. For your game-day experience, a designated non-alcohol parking area is located in the East Fieldhouse Lot.
- Siena Heights University will not be responsible for loss or damage to vehicles or its contents parked for a football game.
- Holders of football parking permits should clearly display their permits from the rearview mirror of their cars to assist parking personnel in directing them to the proper lots. Permits should be displayed at all times.
- Normal parking regulations apply on game day. Vehicles parked in fire lanes, at the end of aisles, and in any other illegal location will be ticketed and/or towed. If you are unable to find a legal parking space, please see a parking attendant for assistance.
- All drivers should follow instructions from the uniformed police officers and parking personnel who will be directing traffic.
- Spaces are available on a first-come, first serve basis, unless you have a pre-paid parking pass.
- Overnight parking is prohibited in all SHU football game-day parking lots.

# TAILGATING POLICY

The Tailgating Policy guides the successful, positive atmosphere represented at Siena Heights University on game days. The following regulations apply to tailgating:

All tailgating participants must demonstrate responsible behavior at all times. Siena Heights fans are expected to demonstrate sportsmanship that reflects our University mission. Siena Heights students are expected to respect the dignity of all, and failure to meet these policies may result in conduct action.

Siena Heights University reserves the right to immediately close tailgating activities and/or remove individuals in its sole discretion. The following items and actions are prohibited:

- Weapons
- Glass containers
- Kegs or mass quantities of alcohol
- Drinking game structures and/or paraphernalia
- Alcohol in the stadium
- Bonfires or fire pits
- Tents or canopies larger than 10'x10'
- Stakes or horseshoes
- Generators
- Couches or upholstered furniture
- Overnight parking
- Fireworks

Designated tailgate locations and times may be restricted by University staff on an event by event basis. Other things to note:

- RVs, buses, and oversized trucks should seek prior approval for the Department of Public Safety to ensure space availability (517-264-7799).
- One parking space is permitted per vehicle.
- Siena Heights University is a tobacco free campus at all times, including our tailgating events.
- Propane grills are permitted; propane tanks that are 15 gallons or less are acceptable.
- Charcoal grills or any open flames are not permitted.
- Tailgating participants are expected to keep an orderly site and clean up after tailgating to return it to the condition it was originally found. The parking lots will be closed to tailgating one hour after the completion of the game.
- Carrying an open container of alcohol on public streets or campus walkways is prohibited regardless of age. When you leave the tailgating area, please leave your beverage behind. Michigan laws for alcohol possession, use, or distribution apply as well as our University policies.
- Violators may be removed from Siena Heights property and could face criminal prosecution.

## **PARKING/COURTESY SHUTTLE SERVICE**

A limited number of single game parking passes for persons needing accessible parking is available in the Stadium Lot on a first-come, first-serve basis on game day for \$5/car: cash only.
