CREATIVE STAGES CLASSES WINTER 2019

Grades 1-2: Mondays—Story Drama 4:15-5:15pm

Students will participate in fun-filled story drama experiences designed to enhance self awareness, physical awareness, verbal expression, creativity and imaginative play.

Grades 3-5: Tuesdays—Dramatic Adventures 4:15-5:15pm

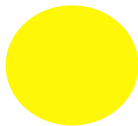
Students will develop adventures through improvisation, creative dramatics, story drama, pantomime, and theatre games.

Grades 6—8: Tuesdays—Improvitational Theatre/Drama 5:30—6:30pm

Students will create “devised theatre” with an emphasis on improvisation, verbal expression, role playing, character development, and movement.

Grades 9—12: Tuesdays—Young Actor’s Workshop 5:30-6:30pm

Students will explore advanced theatre skills through a variety of activities including improvisation, advanced character development, movement for the stage and scene work.



Creative Stages

March 11—April 23



Unique to Lenawee County offering educational theatre for **over 50 years**, our program is *nationally* known and supports a development approach to theatre and drama for children. Our focus is on personal growth of students through the *creative process*. Creative Stages instructors include professional teaching artists, as well as SHU students who are simultaneously studying the theory and practice of educational theatre.

What is the schedule like? We offer a ten-week drama session each fall. We then hold auditions for our main stage children’s performance. (Rehearsals for this performance are held during January with a production in February.) We then offer another session of weekly drama classes. Students must be enrolled in either the fall or winter drama session to participate in the production.
